

Audition requirements:

1. Every Camper must submit an audition video no later than May 1st. **(If you register after May 1st your audition video must be submitted no later than June 30th. If you register after June 1st your audition video must be submitted by July 7th.)**The audition video need not come in the registration packet. The Camper may register for camp and send the video along afterwards. In no way does the audition video mean the Camper will not be accepted to Camp. The video ensures that the Camper will be placed in the proper section for their musical ability.
2. The Camper is required to play the selected audition piece on the instrument that will be playing at Camp. They are also required to play a second piece that they feel best shows their musical ability and skill level. Please keep that piece to a maximum of 32 measures.

The Drummers are required to play Army 2/4 and the Fifers are required to play Rose Tree.

Both pieces are on this site and can be found in The Company of Fifers and Drummers Book 1.

3. Any Camper may audition for **The Advanced Musician** section. This section will be for the Camper that wants to have more of a challenge and wishes to be considered for the Advanced Musician placement. *(There is a section on the registration page that must be checked off if the camper would like to be considered for this placement.)*The Advanced Musician section will consist of 4 bass drummers, 6 snare and 12 fifers and they will be performing the Fife and Drum solos during the Stand piece.
4. The Audition Video must have the Camper's name on the outside of the video and there must be a short introduction at the beginning of the video.

Example of introduction:

"My name is _____ and I will play Army 2/4 as my required piece and for my selected piece I will play _____."

We suggest that you have a slight break between pieces.

(Of course if you are a Fifer you will replace Army 2/4 with Rose Tree.)

5. Please make sure that the video is done as a close up where we only see the performer and please shoot the video straight on. Bass drummers please make sure we see all of your arm movement in the shot.
